## Assistance with Federal Agencies

- Advocate for constituents with their federal issues
- Serve as a neutral facilitator between the constituents and agency
- Provide information about federal agencies and programs
- Refer services (or appropriate public office) that would address their issues appropriately
- Work with policy team to provide oversight of federal agencies



#### **Our Jurisdiction**

- Congressional offices have jurisdiction over federal agencies and must abide by all Federal Laws, Rules, and Regulations.
- We cannot do anything legal (Lawsuits, court cases, child custody, etc.).
- We do not communicate with lawyers unless requested by the constituents.
- It is preferred to work with one congressional office work per case.



# Misconceptions about Congressional Offices

- Congressional casework is the widely held public perception that Members of Congress can initiate a broad array of actions resulting in a speedy, favorable outcome.
- Congressional staff cannot force an agency to expedite a case or act in favor of a constituent.
- We can only ask for consideration of the cases.



#### **Privacy Release Forms**

- Agencies cannot reply to a congressional inquiry without a Privacy Act Release Form signed by the constituent requesting assistance.
- We do not speak to third parties regarding cases unless we have the written permission from a constituent (preferred on the privacy release form).
