





- When contacting agencies ask to speak to their purchasing office to discover if they currently purchase your products / services





## WEBS Registration / Commodity Codes

#### **Commodity Code**

 A product / service-related code(s) to your business. When government purchasers post solicitations & notifications to <u>WEBS</u>, they will select commodity codes that are related to the products / services they are interested in purchasing.



Automobiles: 071-04






# WHATIS WASH Certification?

OMWBE certifies small businesses that are owned & controlled by minorities, women, and other disadvantaged individuals.

OMWBE certifies businesses in order to increase contracting opportunities for the certified businesses with state and local contracts.


