1 SEC. 2. OUTREACH COORDINATOR.

2	Section 1707(d) of the Public Health Service Act (42
3	U.S.C. 300u-6(d)) is amended by adding at the end the
4	following:
5	"(5) Outreach coordinator.—
6	"(A) In general.—In carrying out sub-
7	section (b), the Secretary shall establish within
8	the Office, the position of Outreach Coordi-
9	nator. The Outreach Coordinator shall be ap-
10	pointed by the Secretary, and shall report di-
11	rectly to the Director in the Office of Minority
12	Health.
13	"(B) Duties.—The duties of the Outreach
14	Coordinator shall consist of assisting commu-
15	nity-based organizations navigate the applica-
16	tion for, and any associated conditions on the
17	receipt of, funding available to nongovernmental
18	organizations under grant programs adminis-
19	tered by the Secretary.
20	"(C) Priority.—In providing assistance
