ARPA Defining the American Rescue Plan Act

- Effective March 11, 2021
- \$1.9 trillion economic stimulus package
- Within ARPA, Congress declared that:

State, local, Tribal, and territorial governments may use their allocations of the \$350 billion in Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds to provide "assistance to households, small businesses, **and nonprofits**, or to aid impacted industries."





ARPA Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds

Relief funds given to state and local governments for distribution to aid their communities
Paid in two tranches in May 2021 and ~May 2022
State, local, Tribal, and territorial governments may use their allocations of the \$350 billion in Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds to provide "assistance to households, small businesses, and nonprofits, or to aid impacted industries."




